



Frozen Nights

This hat is made of double yarn - lambswool will give the wearer warmth and mohair will give softness. Perfect for cold winter nights!

Size: one size

Material: Takes about 150 m / 164 yards of aran weight yarn and mohair yarn. I used Novita Jussi and Alvita Pukas (mohair blend).

Also 1 stitch marker and cable needle are required.

Gauge: 20 sts = 10 cm / 4" in cable pattern (Note that cable pattern is more tense than stockinette therefore knit the cable pattern for measuring the gauge!)

Needle size: 4.5 mm (US 7) circular needles (50 cm/20") and double pointing needles

Pattern notes:

K – Knit

P – Purl

K2Tog – Knit 2 together

SKP – Slip 1, Knit 1, pass the slipped stitch over.

C6F – Slip 3 stitches purlwise to a cable needle, and hold to the front of the work. Knit 3 stitches from the left needle. Knit 3 stitches from the cable needle.

C6B - Slip 3 stitches purlwise to a cable needle, and hold to the back of the work. Knit 3 stitches from the left needle. Knit 3 stitches from the cable needle.

C5R - Slip 2 stitches purlwise to a cable needle, and hold to the back of the work. Knit 3 stitches from the left needle. Knit 2 stitches from the cable needle.

C4F - Slip 2 stitches purlwise to a cable needle, and hold to the front of the work. Knit 2 stitches from the left needle. Knit 2 stitches from the cable needle.

C4B - Slip 2 stitches purlwise to a cable needle, and hold to the back of the work. Knit 2 stitches from the left needle. Knit 2 stitches from the cable needle.

Directions:

Cast on 84 sts holding both yarns double. Join in round. Be careful not to twist. Mark the beginning of the round.

Brim

K1, P1. Repeat until the end of round.

Continue like that for 6 more rounds.

Crown

Knit in stockinette Increasing evenly to 120 sts at the same time.

Knit one round.

Start cable pattern:

Round 1. *C6F, K6* Repeat it until the end of the round.



Round 2-4. Knit

Round 5. *K6, C6B* Repeat it until the end of the round.

Round 6-8. Knit

Repeat rounds 1-8 until your work measures about 16 cm / 6.25" ending with round 8.

Now start with decreases. Decreases are done in following way:

Round 1. *C6F, SKP, K4.* Repeat it until the end of the round.

Round 2. Knit

Round 3. K3, *SKP, K9*, SKP, K6

Round 4. Knit

Round 5. *K3, k2Tog, C5R*

Round 6. Knit

Round 7. *K7, SKP*

Round 8. Knit

Round 9. *C4F, SKP, K2*

Round 10. Knit

Round 11. K2, *SKP, K5*, SKP, K3

Round 12. Knit

Round 13. *SKP, C4B*

Round 14. Knit

Round 15. *K2Tog, k3*

Round 16. Knit

Round 17. *K 1, K2Tog*

Round 18. Knit

Round 19. *K2tog, K 1*

Round 20. K2tog

Break the yarn and pull the end through all the stitches.

Finishing:

Weave in the ends. Wash the hat and block it – that will make the stitches look more even and overall the hat will look nicer. You can block it over a plate.
