



Leaves everywhere

This hat has two different leaf motifs hence the name of the pattern.

Size: women small or medium

Material: Titan Wool Winner (50g = 160m), 1 skein

Also a stitch marker is required and a cable needle.

Gauge: 19 sts = 10 cm / 4" in stockinette stitch with larger needles after blocking.

Needle size: 3.5 mm (US 4) and 4.5 mm (US 7) circular needles (50 cm/20") (or other size for getting the right gauge)

Pattern notes:

K – Knit

P – Purl

YO - Yarn over

sl - slip

psso - pass slipped stitch over

K2Tog – Knit 2 together

SKP – Slip 1 stitch knitwise, knit, pass the slipped stitch over

Cable3 - put 1 stitch on cable needle and hold it in front, knit second stitch from left needle, purl first stitch on left needle, knit the stitch from cable needle

Cross left - hold 1 stitch in front on cable needle, purl 1 stitch, knit the stitch from cable needle

Cross right- hold 1 stitch in back on cable needle, knit 1 stitch, purl the stitch from cable needle

m5 - make 5 stitches from 1 stitch by knitting into 1 stitch the following way: k1, yo, k1, yo, k1

Directions:

Cast on 112 sts with smaller needles. Join in round. Be careful not to twist. Mark the beginning of the round. Knit 13 rounds in following way:

Odd numbered rounds: *k1, p1*

Even numbered rounds: knit

Switch to bigger needles. Knit 1 round in stockinette and increase evenly to 128 stitches.

Start knitting the lace:

1) *p3, k3, p12, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, skp, p9*

2) *p3, k3, p12, k5, p9*

3) *p3, cable3, p11, k2tog, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, skp, p8*

4) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p11, k7, p8*

5) *p2, cross right, p1, cross left, p9, k2tog, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, skp, p7*

6) *p2, k1, p3, k1, p9, k9, p7*

7) *p1, cross right, p3, cross left, p7, k2tog, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, skp, p6*

8) *p1, k1, p5, k1, p7, k11, p6*

9) *cross right, p2, m5, p2, cross left, p5, k2tog, k4, yo, k1, yo, k4, skp, p5*



- 10) *k1, p3, k5, p3, k1, p5, k13, p5*
- 11) *cross left, p2, k5, p2, cross right, p5, yo, skp, k9, k2tog, yo, p5*
- 12) *p1, k1, p2, k5, p2, k1, p7, k11, p6*
- 13) *p1, cross left, p1, skp, k1, k2tog, p1, cross right, p7, yo, skp, k7, k2tog, yo, p6*
- 14) *p2, k1, p1, k3, p1, k1, p9, k9, p7*
- 15) *p2, cross left, sl1, k2tog, pssso, cross right, p9, yo, skp, k5, k2tog, yo, p7*
- 16) *p3, k3, p11, k7, p8*
- 17) *p3, cable3, p11, yo, skp, k3, k2tog, yo, p8*
- 18) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p12, k5, p9*
- 19) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p12, yo, skp, k1, k2tog, yo, p9*
- 20) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p13, k3, p10*
- 21) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p13, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, p10*
- 22) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p14, k1, p11*
- 23) *p3, cable3, p12, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, skp, p9*
- 24) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p12, k5, p9*

- 29) *cross right, p2, m5, p2, cross left, p6, k2tog, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, skp, p6*
- 30) *k1, p3, k5, p3, k1, p6, k11, p6*
- 31) *cross left, p2, k5, p2, cross right, p6, skp, k7, k2tog, p6* 34 sts
- 32) *p1, k1, p2, k5, p2, k1, p7, k9, p6*
- 33) *p1, cross left, p1, skp, k1, k2tog, p1, cross right, p7, skp, k5, k2tog, p6* 30 sts
- 34) *p2, k1, p1, k3, p1, k1, p8, k7, p6*
- 35) *p2, cross left, sl1, k2tog, pssso, cross right, p8, skp, k3, k2tog, p6* 26 sts
- 36) *p3, k3, p9, k5, p6*
- 37) *p3, cable3, p9, skp, k1, k2tog, p6* 24 sts
- 38) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p9, k3, p6*
- 39) *p3, k1 p1, k1, p9, sl1, k2tog, pssso, p6* 22 sts
- 40) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p9, k1, p6*
- 41) *p3, cable3, p8, sl1, k2tog, pssso, p5* – 20 sts
- 42) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p8, k1, p5*
- 43) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p7, sl1, k2tog, pssso, p4* 18sts
- 44) *p3, k1, p1, l1, p7, k1, p4*
- 45) *p3, cable3, p6, sl1, k2tog, pssso, p3* 16 sts
- 46) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p6, k1, p3*
- 47) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p5, sl1, k2tog, pssso, p2* 14 sts
- 48) *p3, k1, p1, k1, p5, k1, p2*
- 49) *p3, sl1, k2tog, pssso, p4, sl1, k2tog, pssso, p1* 10 sts
- 50) *p3, k1, p4, k1, p1*
- 51) *p2, sl1, k2tog, pssso, p2, sl1, k2tog, pssso* 6 sts



52) *p2, k1, p2, k1*

53) *p1, sl1, k2tog, pss0, p1, k1* 4 sts

54) *k2tog*

Break the yarn and pull the end through all the stitches.

Finishing:

Weave in the ends. Wash the hat and block it – that will make the stitches look more even and overall the hat will look nicer.
